2024-2 Osprey Minor Hockey Penalty Accumulation Policy

It is Osprey Minor Hockey's mission to develop hockey players that play hard and disciplined within Hockey Canada's rulebook. In order to support the mission of Osprey Minor Hockey, the following Penalty Accumulation Policy is now in effect:

Once a player reaches the following penalty minute thresholds, the listed course of action will take place to keep the player mindful of their actions and to keep them responsible for their conduct on the ice.

1. 40 penalty minutes

Subject to a meeting involving the player and their parents, bench staff of the team and an executive member.

2. 60 penalty minutes

Player is subject to a 1 game suspension, served fully dressed on the bench, within a 7 day period following the game that the player broke the 60 minute mark. It must be a scheduled league game or tournament game, an exhibition game does not count toward the suspension.

3. 80 penalty minutes

Player and parents receive a letter from the Executive Board stating the future consequences of suspension for the remainder of the season

4. 100 penalty minutes

Player situation receives full review by the Executive Board, which will consist of:

- Review of GameSheet recorded penalty stats
- A risk management interview with the player and parents
- Based on the findings of the review, the player can receive a suspension for the remainder of the season, with no refund of registration fees.
